

Grants for research students attending 7ICAANE

The London Centre for the Ancient Near East (LCANE), acting for the British Association for the Ancient Near East (BANEAE), has set aside a limited fund to meet the registration fees of research students at British universities who have already registered for or propose to attend the seventh International Congress on the Archaeology of the Ancient Near East (7ICAANE, www.7icaane.org) in London in April 2010.

Applicants are required to submit to the Treasurer of LCANE a CV and a personal statement of not more than 200 words, explaining the nature of their research projects and the reasons why they wish to attend 7ICAANE. The deadline for submission is 28 February 2010.

Successful applicants will be notified of the award of grants by 12 March. Grants will be conditional on attendance at the congress and receipt by LCANE of a short report on the proceedings, and will be disbursed after the congress.

Applicants should already be student members of the British Association for Near Eastern Archaeology (BANEAE), or should join on application (www.baneae.org). The funds available from LCANE supplement the attendance grants already advertised by BANEAE, for which the deadline has already passed.

LCANE funds are available to cover the registration fee of 7ICAANE only. Registration for 7ICAANE is the responsibility of the applicant.
